<p>The Terms of Reference state "self-assembly" computers with requirements for the motherboard, a choice from the list provided, disks, and memory. Will you consider other manufacturers that are not worth in functionality?</p>	<p>Especially with e.g. SSD memory items but also the other listed items quality is important and relevant. Other well-established brands for these items are also possible but no no-name brands.</p>
<p>2. Questions about 27-inch (graphic) monitors, which states out strict requirements. Will you consider if we offer an option under 2 times cheaper price but a little less on the color palette, for example (model - U2720Q, which meets the requirements of brightness, response, but does not satisfy a little on the color palette (99% sRGB, 99% Rec 709, 95% DCI-P3, Delta E <2 (Average)) and no calibration, but the price of such a monitor in the GPL is \$ 840 against \$ 1900 for UP2718Q (which has everything as required, except the reaction time - 6ms)</p>	<p>The specifications of the proposed monitor (U2720Q) are still within the acceptable range, so we'd be fine with that monitor.</p>
